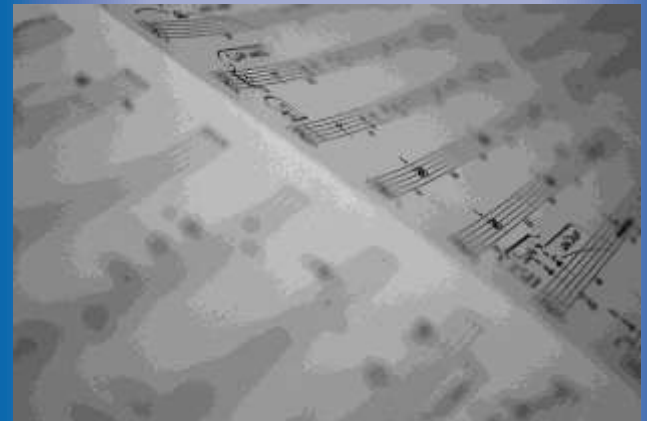




HEAT UP YOUR SUMMER!

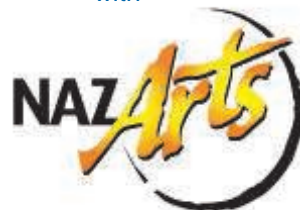
